3 Get a single note! That is essential!

3.1 Counting Eighth Notes: 1 and 2 and 3 and 4 and 1 etc...

Use lots of staccatto, which is sounding a short note, not necessarily the shortest note, for half of its value, but do not apply staccatto to any note before a rest. A rest explicitly states exactly when a note is supposed to end.
