This piece is a gentle introduction to barring. [2a means bar the second fret with the "A" string the lowest note barred. The arpeggio mark with up arrowhead means that the top note is played last. That is obvious, but often in guitar music the up-arpeggio mark indicates rasgueado, so it is necessary to assure you that in this case each note is only played once.
